

# JV Lady Bison win two more

## VS TRINITY

BHS travelled to Trinity last Tuesday, where the Lady Bison junior varsity pulled out 25-19 win.

Neither junior varsity team could get a shot to fall at the start of the game Tuesday night. Buffalo managed one lay up in the first period to nudge ahead of Trinity who finished with a free throw. The Lady Bison scored seven points in the second quarter to Trinity's four for a 9-5 half time score. Buffalo doubled their score in the third and led 18-9 going into the final six minutes. Trinity poured in ten points in the fourth quarter, but Buffalo added seven for the 25-18 victory.

Kelsey Canady poured in twelve points, including all the points in the first half, to lead the Lady Bison. Reagan Read pumped in eight points. Emily Grissett and Samantha Atkinson added two points each. Tristan Brewer tacked on one.

## VS NEW WAVERLY

The junior varsity Lady Bison used shut out defense to score a 29-14 win over New Waverly. Buffalo gave up only two points the first half as they scored twelve of their own.

The Lady Bison added another seven points in the third to extend their lead to 19-7 going into the final minutes of play. Buffalo was 100% from the free throw line in the fourth quarter as they bucketed another ten points for the 29-14 win.

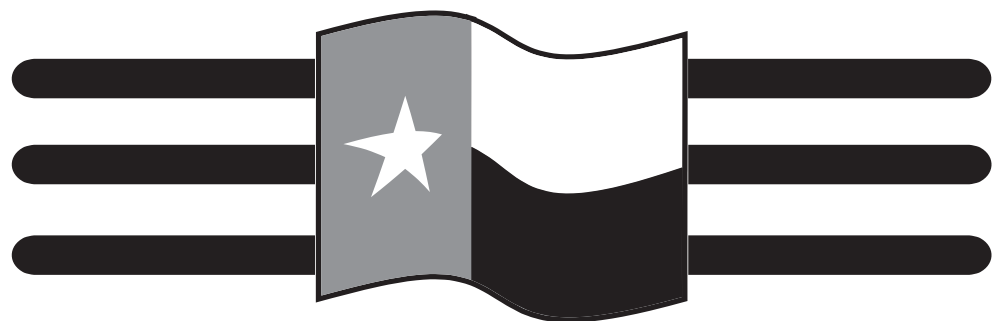


