Caller said okay for Officers to come to their residence, arrest the 5 year old and dig up their Dad....It took a little doing, but Leslie was able to get Mother to the phone.....Father doesn't even live in Texas, and nope, no homicide has occurred....at least yet.....But there may be one when she gets off the phone with Dispatcher Leslie!
